Print the outline of the drawing of St. Peter. Children can add the details of his face with colored pencils or glue scraps of material to make his hair and a beard. Color or glue scraps of material on the cutout garment. Cutout the garment and glue onto the St. Peter cutout. Add the staff to represent Peter as the shepherd of God's flock and church on earth.

As the children are working on their St. Peter cutout, you may want to remind them that St. Peter was the first pope. Jesus gave the keys of the Kingdom to Peter. When Jesus died and went to Heaven, Peter was left in charge of Jesus' Church on earth. Peter was the first pope. Ask the children if they know who our pope is today.
