Palm/Passion Sunday

*Mark 11:1-10 *Isaiah 50:4-7 *Philippians 2:6-11* Mark 14:1-15:47*

***“...every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory of God the Father.” – Phil. 2:11***

Today we reflect on Christ’s passion and death. In the midst of the story it is hard to believe that “every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.” Most voices at this moment are condemning him.
