All Saints Day Activity

Saint Paper Chain

MATERIALS:

- ❖ Strips of construction Paper
- ❖ Markers or Colored Pencils
- ❖ Stapler or Tape

DIRECTIONS:

- ❖ As a family discuss that November 1 is the Feast of All Saints, a day when we remember those who have died and are in heaven.
- ❖ Have family members think of a person who has died or their favorite saint. OR Google who would be the patron saint of an activity your family enjoys doing together. After you have the saint's name go to <https://www.catholic.org/saints/> to find out more about the saint.
- ❖ Another option would be for each family member find the patron saint of activities they like to do and have them write those saints names on strips of paper.
- ❖ Everyone can decorate the strips however they like.
- ❖ Take the strips and staple/tape them together.
- ❖ Hang your Family Saint Paper Chain where family members can see it every day to remember those that have died.
- ❖ After the Saint Paper Chain is hung, remind family members that All Saints Day is a day to remember those who have died and are in heaven.
